



The ART of Christmas 2021

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Entries can be two-dimensional or three-dimensional artwork, the subject of which should address the general theme, and which must be the original artwork of the entrant. Photography will not be accepted.
- 2. Entries must not require electricity or connection to an electrical outlet.
- 3. Standalone (3D) entries must be stable and capable of safely supporting their own weight.
- 4. There is a limit of one (1) entry per artist. Maximum size of hanging artworks must not exceed 1m x 1m x 1m; maximum size of trees not to exceed 1.5m x 1m x 1m (h x w x d).
- 5. Artworks must be suitably framed for hanging or free standing, with D-rings only and hanging wire. Blu-tak, eyelet screws or other devices are not suitable. Place clearly written name, address and title of the artwork on the top right back of the entry. Stretched canvases are considered framed.
- Entries, together with a completed Entry Form indicating the category in which the work is to be entered, should be left at the Roxby Downs Community Library. All entries must be submitted by Thursday 2 December. The exhibition will be installed and uninstalled by Roxby Council and Roxby Link gallery staff. Entries without a completed Entry Form will not be accepted.
- 7. No payments whatsoever will be made for freight or other charges incurred in the delivery or return of an entry. Any freight needed must be pre-paid by the entrant. Entries consigned with no return freight provision will not be the responsibility of the Roxby Link gallery and will be discarded.
- Entries must be collected between the 24th of January and the 28th of January 2022. The Roxby Link gallery cannot store any work or other items belonging to the Exhibitor before or after the Exhibition. Please ensure all work is removed from the gallery on the day/s the Exhibition is dismantled.
- 9. The Roxby Link gallery management reserves the right to refuse to accept or display any entries that they deem to be unsuitable for the exhibition. All work will be viewed by judges appointed by the organisers but may not necessarily be hung. The judges' decisions will be final and neither discussion nor correspondence will be entered into.
- 10. The Roxby Link gallery will exercise all reasonable care with entries submitted, but will not accept responsibility for loss or damage while they are in its custody. Adequate precautions must be taken in packing entries as no responsibility will be taken for damaged or lost works.
- 11. The entrant grants the Roxby Link gallery a non-exclusive license to reproduce any works entered in the *"The ART of Christmas 2021"* for the purposes of publicity. Authorship will be acknowledged where appropriate. The entrant retains all other copyright on their artwork/s.
- 12. Prizes will be awarded to the first prize winner in each of the following four categories: Business/ Community Group/Organisation, Family, Adult, Child/Class.
- 13. As the Roxby Link gallery is a multi-purpose venue, Roxby Link management reserve the right to utilise the gallery space as an event venue to hold small community functions throughout the year without further consent from the Exhibitor.
- 14. The Roxby Link gallery supplies wall labels for the Exhibition based on labelling information supplied by the Exhibitor with this form.
- 15. The Roxby Link gallery is responsible for the provision of public liability insurance within the gallery space and other exhibition spaces within Roxby Link. Monitored CCTV of the gallery space is provided and the gallery is locked during non-opening times. The Roxby Link gallery will not be responsible for any damage, theft or authenticity claims for the duration of the exhibition and in signing the artist waives all right against damage, theft and authenticity claims for the duration of the exhibition.
